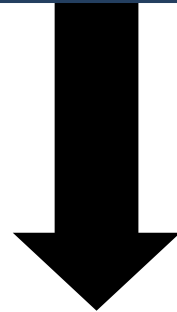

2. WROTE HUMROUS COLUMN TITLED “ KRIPABOR BORUAR KAKOTOR TOPOLA” IN JONAKI MAGAZINE

3. Jonaki was an Assamese language magazine published from **Calcutta in 1889**. It was also the mouthpiece of the then Assamese literary society **Asamiya Bhasa Unnati Sadhini Sabha** in which the society's aim and objectives were regularly expressed.

- The first editor of the magazine was **Chandra Kumar Agarwala**.
- **Publisher**: Asamiya Bhasa Unnati Sadhini Sabha
- **First issue date**: 9 February 1889

TOPIC 30: GOLDEN SILK PARK AND COMMERCIAL CENTRE AT KHANAPARA

- Assam CM inaugurates golden silk park and commercial centre ON APRIL 1, 2023
- Assam Chief Minister Dr Himanta Biswa Sarma on Saturday inaugurated a golden silk park and commercial centre at **Resham Nagar** at **Khanapara in Guwahati**.
- Apart from providing silkworm breed to silkworm farmers, this initiative by the Handloom and Textiles and Sericulture Department would also provide a platform to indigenous silk weavers to sell their produce.
- He appealed to the Handloom and Textiles Department to launch a massive publicity drive to make the **'Swanirbhar Nari'** scheme a household name across the length and breadth of the State.

TOPIC 31: Recently, the Indian Prime Minister laid the foundation stone of Maa Kamakhya Divya Pariyojana (Maa Kamakhya Access Corridor).

- It has been sanctioned under the **Prime Minister's Development Initiative for North Eastern Region (PM-DevINE)** scheme.
- Situated on the **Nilachal hills** in **Guwahati, Assam**, Kamakhya temple is a significant pilgrimage centre.
- The temple is dedicated to different forms of Mother Shakti, namely **Sundari, Tripura, Tara, Bhuvaneshvari, Bagalamukhi and Chinnamasta**.
- **Ambubachi Mela** is one of the major festivals of this temple. The festival is held every year to **commemorate the yearly menstruation of Goddess Kamakhya**.
- **About Kamakhya temple:**
 - Located in Nilachal Hills, Guwahati. It is one of the 51 shaktipeethas. Kamakhya Maa is considered the goddess of fertility.
 - The temple's architectural shape is a combination of the traditional nagara and saracenic styles. This hybrid architecture is sometimes called the Nilachal type, named after the hill where it's located.
 - The temple has a distinctive beehive-like shikhara (dome). The dome is adorned with sculptured panels and images of various Hindu deities.
 - Kamakhya Temple hosts the famous **Ambubachi Mela**. This is an annual festival celebrating the menstruation of the goddess.

TOPIC 32:SIKSHA SETU AXOM PORTAL

1. Shiksha Setu Axom (Assam) is a complete digital platform with 360-degree information about schools, staff and students. It is launched to serve as a single source of information for day-to-day administrative operations that relate to education.

The government of Assam launched this portal to take timely and data-driven decisions to optimise education sector resources and improve its overall performance.

2. The Shiksha Setu Axom portal was officially inaugurated during an event program in Guwahati on **24th April 2023**, to offer several benefits and features. Assam Education Minister Ranoj Pegu was present during the launch event, also read the [India Today Axom Setu news report](#). **The primary aim of the portal**

is to collect extensive data regarding schools in the state.

TOPIC 33: Promotion of Tribal Products for North East Region (PTP-NER 2.0)

- The Tribal Cooperative Marketing Development Federation of India Ltd. (TRIFED) has launched phase 2 of the ‘Promotion of Tribal Products for North East Region’ (PTP-NER 2.0) scheme.

About the Scheme:

- It is a **Central Sector scheme** and is launched by the **Ministry of Tribal Affairs**.
- This scheme aims to enhance procurement, logistics and marketing of tribal products from the North East Region.
- It will be implemented in **eight states** of North Eastern Region- **Arunachal Pradesh, Assam, Manipur, Meghalaya, Mizoram, Nagaland, Tripura and Sikkim**.
- The scheme has been implemented in **two phases**:
 - In the **First Phase** of the scheme , 8 states and 38 districts were covered. Organisation of **64 Tribal Artisans Empanelment Melas (TAeM)** were done by the **teams of TRIFED and North Eastern Handicrafts and Handlooms Development Corporation (NEHHDC)**. A variety of products were procured ranging from **textiles, forest produce, bamboo items, jewelry, pottery, paintings, etc.**
 - In the **Second Phase** of the scheme, 29 districts will be covered by the teams of TRIFED and NEHHDC to reach out to tribal artisans and showcase their cultural heritage.

- AS PART OF THIS PLAN, **68 TRIBAL** ARTISAN MELAS WILL BE ORGANISED IN DIFFERENT DISTRICTS OF THE REGION.

Significance of the Scheme

- It will strengthen the job opportunities for tribal artisans by promoting their products.
- It will improve tribal products' global value chain and create sustainable livelihoods for tribal communities.
- The scheme would uplift the socio-economic status of tribal artisans while preserving and promoting their rich traditional craftsmanship and cultural heritage.

Tribal Cooperative Marketing Development Federation of India Ltd. (TRIFED)

- It is a **national-level apex** organization functioning under the administrative control of the **Ministry of Tribal Affairs**. It acts as a facilitator and service provider for tribes to sell their product.
- It aims to **empower tribal people** with knowledge, tools, and a pool of information so that they can undertake their operations in a more systematic and scientific manner.
- Its **objective is the socio-economic development of tribal people** in the country by way of marketing development of the tribal products such as metal craft, tribal textiles, pottery, tribal paintings, and pottery on which the tribals depend heavily for a major portion of their income.

North Eastern Handicrafts and Handlooms Development Corporation (NEHHDC)

- It was incorporated in **1977** and aims to develop and promote the indigenous crafts of the region. It is under the **Ministry of Development of North Eastern Region (DoNER), Government of India**.

– Objectives:

1. Providing financial, technical and other assistance to craftsmen, weavers, co-operatives and other establishments.

2. Establish, operate and promote Sales Centres, like emporia, show-rooms, publicity offices and exhibition cells for improving accessibility of the goods.
3. Organise production through co-operatives, artisans or its own production centres.
4. Promote and operate schemes for development of handicrafts, handlooms and allied products.
5. Establish production centers for those craft industries where the demand is growing.
6. Provide training for multiplying and upgrading traditional skills.

TOPIC 34 :GUINNESS WORLD RECORD FOR HEMKOSH

The Braille edition of 'Hemkosh the first etymological dictionary of the Assamese language dictionary of the Assamese language, has entered the Guinness World Records, an official said on May 1, 2023.

The publisher of 'Hemkosh' and chairman of Pratidin Media Network Jayanta Baruah received the Guinness World Records certificate of 'largest bilingual braille dictionary' from Rishi Nath, official adjudicator for Guinness World Records on the occasion of the 127th death anniversary of 'Bhaxar Oja' Hemchandra Baruah on Monday.

The Guinness World Records official certificate presentation ceremony of Hemkosh's Braille Edition 'largest bilingual braille dictionary' was held at the

Birinchi Kumar Baruah (BKB) Auditorium, Gauhati University.

The braille edition is the adaption of Hemkosh's 14th Edition's regular dictionary.

The first Assamese language dictionary, 'Hemkosh', was compiled by late Hemchandra Baruah in the last part of the 19th century, and was published four years later after his demise.

Moreover 'Hemkosh' is the first etymological dictionary of the Assamese language and is bilingual in nature, thus children can benefit in both English and Assamese languages from the dictionary".
